The 7th Annual Meeting of the **Internet Governance Forum (IGF)** was hosted by the Government of the Republic of Azerbaijan from 6. to 9. November 2012 in Baku. The overall theme of the IGF 2012 was Internet Governance for Sustainable Human, Economic and Social Development. **Mr Blaz Golob**, director CeGD took part in a workshop on ***Regional and Country-level Internet Governance Forums: What's at stake and who's involved?***.



Mr. Golob delivered a speech to high level government officials on “eGovernance supporting development of post-oil economy” at Center for Strategic Studies under the President of the Republic of Azerbaijan

During the Forum Mr Golob met with high level government officials together with Dr. Reyhan Huseynova, president and founder of the Azerbaijan Future Studies Society and Mr Jerome C. Glenn, director of the Millennium Project.
